Location and parking



Norton Cancer Institute - Madison is located on the east side of the hospital's main campus at 1373 E. State Road 62, Madison, Indiana. Parking is available in front of the cancer center entrance.

When entering the main campus off of E. State Road 62, turn right and follow the primary road until you see the cancer center entrance on your left.

Patients may be dropped off under the protective awning during inclement weather or anytime it is more comfortable. Wheelchairs are available for patients who need assistance.


Inspired and accredited

Medical oncology - infusion bays

If your treatment includes chemotherapy or immunotherapy, you will receive infusions in one of our beautiful infusion bays or in a comfortable private room. The cancer center features seven infusion chairs and two private rooms.

Our infusion nurses have a wealth of experience and all are certified in chemotherapy and immunotherapy administration. The length of your infusion depends upon your specific treatment. Before treatment, you will receive one-on-one education with a certified nurse. This is a great opportunity to ask questions.

Support person welcome

You may have a support person with you during the infusion process. We welcome and encourage you to invite a spouse, family member or friend. Support persons must be at least 18 years of age.





Heated chairs Our infusion chair

Our infusion chairs offer several comforting options. Chairs recline and most of them are heated, which can be very soothing during the treatment process.

Calming views

Infusion chairs can be turned in any direction, allowing you to watch television, read a book or magazine, take a nap, or just look outside at the calm surroundings.

Radiation therapy

A variety of radiation therapy services are available at Norton Cancer Institute - Madison. In fact, we feature one of the most advanced, state-of the-art linear accelerators in the region.

Precision matters during radiation treatments, allowing physicians and trained radiation therapists to deliver highly targeted radiation designed to destroy cancer cells or keep them from growing and dividing. Targeted therapies allow our team to deliver higher doses of radiation therapy while also protecting healthy tissue, which reduces unwanted side effects.

Your oncology provider will determine whether radiation therapy is appropriate for your care. If your care plan involves radiation treatments, rest assured that our team will answer all of your questions and guide you through every step of the process.
